No. 26015/20/2007-Cus-AS dated 16.02.2012 for hiring of 2 vehicles for EMC, DGHRD, F.No. 26015/03/2012-Cus-AS dated 05.03.2012 for hiring of 1 vehicle for Centre of Excellence, NACEN, Delhi, F.
